Rural town of 1500 inhabitants, Felletin grew economically during the XIVth and the XVth centuries thanks to the craft activities settled on the banks of the river Creuse: flour mill, spinning mill, sawmill, fulling mill, paper mill, diamond cutting cooperative...

Below the Limousine mountain, Felletin is one of the entrance towns of regional natural Park of Millevaches en Limousin. This implies that it's an ancient merchant crossroads, and nowadays, Felletin has one of the largest farmers' markets in the Creuse department.

Felletin is considered as the cradle of the low-heddle tapestry, classified as intangible cultural heritage of UNESCO since 2009. This is why the city is a reference in textiles activities. It's also a city of builders with a homogeneous and really preserved heritage, shaped for centuries by its inhabitants. This traditional way of building is perpetuated by the teachings taught at the Lycée des Métiers du Bâtiment, the first building school in France.



FPE ensures and offers a tourist offer in connection with these themes and with the development strategy of the Textile Arts / Woven Arts Pole of the Creuse Grand Sud Community of Municipalities, the International Tapestry City in Aubusson and the Lainamac training centre and association for the wool sector.

With this objective of promoting local know-how, FPE organizes too The International Wool Days, one of the most important wool festival in France. After twenty-four years of existence this event welcomes more than 20 000 visitors and has a dual ambition: to contribute to the structuring of the wool industry by participating in its promotion and enhancement to the general public, and to generate economic benefits for the local stakeholders.
